

PRECINCT CAUCUS IN FIVE EASY STEPS

NOTICE: The Natrona County Republican Party does not vote for the presidential nominee at this caucus!

#1 CHECK IN, FIND YOUR SEAT

Check in at the door and sit with others from your precinct.

#2 DELEGATE

If you are a Precinct Committeeman or woman introduce yourself and volunteer to Chair your Precinct Caucus. Otherwise, elect someone to act as the Precinct Caucus Chairman. Now, choose someone with decent handwriting to act as the secretary to complete the forms.

#3 PROPOSE REVISIONS

The Precinct County Chairman should now ask if anyone would like to present a proposal to amend, add or delete anything in the Republican Platform, Resolutions, or Bylaws.

Use a submission form to submit a legible final draft of each proposal. The schedule allocates 30 minutes each for set of revisions.

HINTS:

- If you cannot come to an agreement on opposing proposals submit both.
- If you are unfamiliar with the Republican Platform and Resolutions, start by reading the category most important to you.
- Keep track of time we will adjourn at 9pm sharp!

#4 ELECT DELEGATES and ALTERNATS TO THE COUNTY CONVENTION

Members of the Central and Executive committees are automatic delegates to the County Convention. If your precinct has an unfilled committeeman or committeewoman seat you may to elect a registered Republican from your precinct to fill the vacancy. Make a prioritized list of alternates from your precinct to replace any absent delegates. Nominees do not have to be present to be elected.

#5 COMPLETE AND TURN IN FORMS

Please, complete the Delegate and Alternate Report, Precinct Caucus Report, then sort and stack the proposals for changes to the Republican Bylaws, Platform and Resolutions.

Your help is appreciated!
